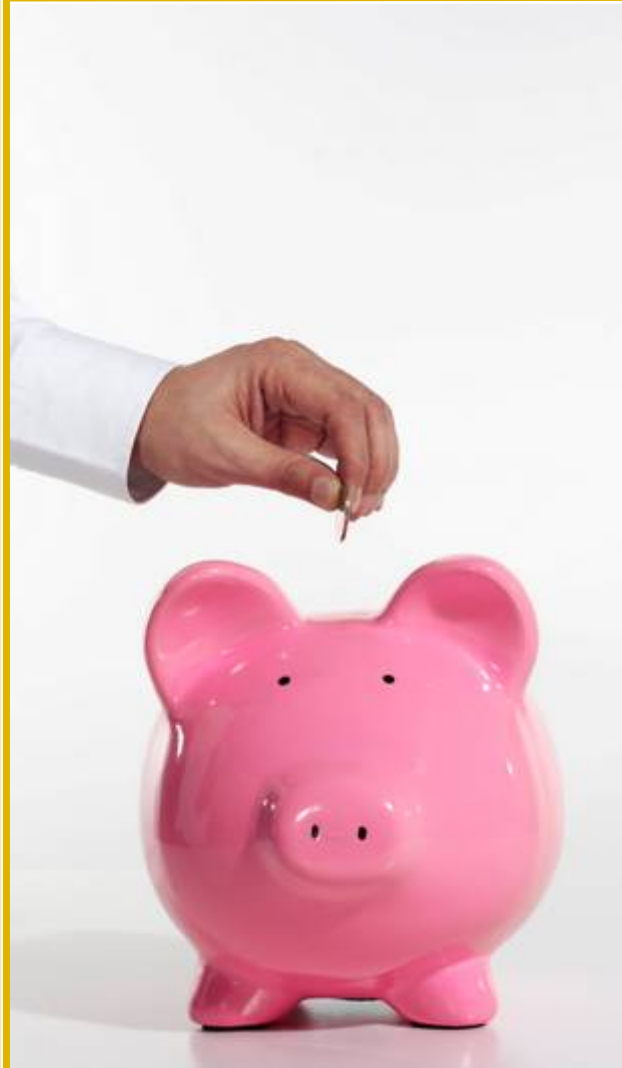


Preserving Assets
