

Export Documentation

EC Certificate of Origin, EUR1, EUR-MED and ATR Certificates and Other Documents

As from 1st January 2019 the above documents will be charged at the following rates:

- Members: £29.00 plus VAT per document (including administration and postage costs)
- Non-members: £58.00 plus VAT per document (including administration and postage costs)

Preparation of Export documentation will be charged at:

- £60.00 plus VAT

Preparation and submission of Export Customs Declarations:

The Chambers export declaration service allows exporters to have control over their exports, ensure the correct procedures and audit paperwork is in place for goods exiting the UK. Taking the pressure of exporters by working with a trusted and reliable compliance Partner.

- £20.00 Plus VAT

Counter Service

The counter service hours of 1000 to 1200 and 1400 to 1600 (call-in fee) will be charged at:

- Member £24.00 (plus VAT)
- Non-Members and £48 (plus VAT).

ECert Express Premium Service

For urgent documents the exporter can select this option and documents will be processed by the Chamber within a two-hour time slot. Additional fee of £12.00 plus VAT (members) £24.00 plus VAT (non-members) applies.

Blank Documentation

One pack of 20 documents will be charged at:

- Members: £25.50 plus VAT (including administration and postage costs)
- Non-members: £51.00 plus VAT (including administration and postage costs)

Electronic Documentation

We offer the e-z Cert facility for exporters, at no extra cost, to produce and submit all export documents online, which is convenient, reduces precious time for export staff and saves the cost of the call-in/counter fee for same day certification.
